



## Welcome to the 2023 NMAEA Conference!

### Directions:

GPS will want to route many of you to N. Ave K. We recommend **N. Ave O** instead, which brings you through the sports area to a stop sign at West University Dr., turn left ½ block, and at the light, you'll be at West 2nd St (Hwy 70). South of this intersection University Dr. becomes S. Ave N. This is the intersection for all attendees: **HWY 70 & S Avenue N**

You will see the **ENMU Theatre Center** on the southeast corner. Head south on S Avenue N, and the Art & Anthropology Building will be on your right. The center of Campus will be on your left.

### Parking:

Park anywhere along S. Ave N, or park in the parking lot just past the building on the left. If you are staying at the Super 8 or Holiday Inn Express, you are to the West and could walk, if preferred. Best western Plus is a few blocks away / downtown, across from Coffee Shop and Brewery. Presenters can park and load in/out in front of either the A&A or the Annex.

### Locations:

Art & Anthropology Building (A&A): Westside of the center of campus

- Most workshops are located inside the Art and Anthropology Building (A&A)

Art Annex: southwest of A&A building (On Sesame St!!)

- Some workshops are located out the back of A&A Building, and down the alley at the Art Annex (about one short block)
