

Division Representatives

Division Representatives are appointed by the Executive Officers (EO) and have no set term. Positions will be reviewed yearly by the EO.

There are eight Division Representatives supporting NMAEA divisions of art education:

- Pre Service Representative
- Elementary Representative
- Middle School Representative
- High School Representative
- Higher Education Representative
- Administration Representative
- Retired Representative
- Museum Representative

The Division Representatives support and advocate the issues and concerns of their specific division level as they pertain to art education in New Mexico. They are a point of contact for the New Mexico art educators specific to their division statewide, regardless of membership.

Additional duties include:

- Fulfilling the Association's Mission and Bylaws.
- Providing monthly reports to the Division Chair
- Work with the Division Chair to create and report the status of annual plan of work.
- Provide and maintain pertinent content information for their division level on a web page at the NMAEA website.
- Outreaching statewide to their division level art teachers as a resource, mentor, colleague, as well as specifically promoting networking and professional development within their division.
- Promote the Association, its programs, and membership for the good of the order.
- Networking with the National Division Director of their specific level.
- Managing art teacher's contact information for their specific division level in the New Mexico Art Educators list provided by the PED.
- Serve on the Divisions Committee to provide quality professional development around New Mexico.
- Work closely with the Membership Chair to assist with membership recruitment.
- Serve on the Conference Committee if needed.
- Attend annual conference and lead a Division Level Leadership meeting to share and obtain information specific to the concerns of divisional, state, and national art educators.
- Keep records of the office held and provide information to the new division representative.
